

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE MAIN STREET OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCHESTER MILLS, GRANT TOWNSHIP, INDIANA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BEING LEGISLATIVE ROUTE NO. 32089 FROM THE NASHVILLE ROAD, SOUTH TO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PROPERTY

Be it ordained and enacted by the Grant Township Supervisors, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained by authority of same:

SECTION 1: Term vehicle as used in this Ordinance shall apply to every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices moved by human power.

SECTION 2: No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon the east side of the Main Street of the Village of Rochester Mills, being known as Legislative Route No. 32089, from the Nashville Road South to the Elementary School property. This prohibition shall extend to and include the area of the legal right of way on the east side of said highway.

SECTION 3: That prohibition of parking on the east side of the Main Street of the Village of Rochester Mills, Grant Township, Indiana County, Pennsylvania, as hereinabove set forth shall be designated by proper signs or other appropriate markings placed on or near the curb line which shall read "No Parking".

SECTION 4: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of ten (\$10.00) Dollars for the first offense, Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars for the second offense and Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for any subsequent offenses provided that the amount of each fine as set forth above shall be reduced by one-half if paid within twenty-four (24) hours from the time of the offense. In default of the payment of the fine, the offender shall undergo imprisonment of three (3) days for the first offense and five (5) days for each subsequent offense. Said fine or penalty to be imposed as a result of summary proceedings before any magistrate, and all fines collected shall be paid to the Township for the construction or repair and maintenance of the highways thereof.
